RAAH Leadership Council - It is the responsibility of the Leadership Council to act as the governing entity for RAAH and to adopt rules and operating procedures as it deems necessary to carry out its responsibilities under State and Federal legislation.

RAAH General Membership - RAAH general membership meetings are used to network and identify emerging community issues and needs that related to homelessness. RAAH meetings are used to identify policy issues that should be forwarded to the Leadership Council. Committees may be formed and disbanded by RAAH as needed. Committees are to provide recommendations to the Leadership Council and keep the RAAH membership informed of their progress. **They can place agenda items on the RAAH agenda or forward agenda topics to the Leadership Council for input.** There are two types of Committees: 1) Standing Committees that meet year-round to fulfill specific duties and 2) Working groups that are ad hoc and meet for a specific purpose, which upon completion, they disband.
